Order int the most important to you Things to consider:

Plan A

- when to go to birth place
- Membrane sweeps
- VE and Monitoring
- your Environment
- Use of Pools/bed/positions
- Artificial rupture of membranes
- Pain Relief pharmaceutical entinox, pethidine, epidural
- pain relief nonpharmaceutical
- aromatherapy, massage, water
- coaching during second stage
- third stage (natural or managed)
- optimal cord clamping and cord cutting
- golen hour (undisturbed, breastfeeding, skin to skin)
- vitamin k
- Afterbirth

Plan B

Induction preferences

- Induction by membrane sweep
- induction for post date
- Vaginal Examiniations after release of membranes
- artificial intervention (forceps etc)
- other augmentation of labour (the drip etc)

plan C

Caesarean Section

- emergency/ unplanned/ elective
- partner (touch/ Involvement)
- breathing techniques
- music
- curtain lowered
